Sessions available

Our nursery will be open from 7:30am to 5:45pm weekdays during term times.

We will be offering high-quality childcare throughout the whole day. Between 8:50pm and 3:20pm is our core school day offer. During this time, our early years foundation teacher will be engaged with the children throughout the provision.

Sessions available are:

- Full day offer (7.30am- 5.45pm)
- School day offer (8.50am 3.20pm)

For those families who require different arrangements, we can offer additional sessions or combinations to suit individual needs.

Fees

Are you entitled to free childcare hours? Please visit <u>Childcare Choices</u> to find out more about funding. We welcome families using free funded hours, tax-free childcare, bank transfers and vouchers.

Costs for paid sessions:

2 year old fees (hourly rate £5:45):

- Fees for a full day 7.30am- 5.45pm: £55.86
- Fees for a school day 8.50am 3.20pm: £35.43

Individual sessions:

-Early morning session (7.30am - 8.50am): £7.27

-Morning session 8.50am - 11.50am: £16.35

-Lunch session: £2.73

-Afternoon session 12.20pm - 3.20pm: £16.35

-Late afternoon session (3.20pm - 5.45pm): £13.17

3 and 4 year old fees (hourly rate £4:85):

- Fees for a full day (7.30am- 5.45pm) £49.71
- Fees for a school day (8.50am 3.20pm) £31.53

Individual sessions:

-Early morning session (7.30am - 8.50am): £6.47

-Morning session 8.50am - 11.50am: £14.55

-Lunch session: £2.43

-Afternoon session 12.20pm - 3.20pm: £14.55

-Late afternoon session (3.20pm - 5.45pm): £11.72

Hot school meals can be provided for children at an additional cost of £2:40.

Included in our prices:

- Snacks, breakfast and milk
- Nappies and wipes (as required)

N.B. If your child has any special requirements or requires specific brands, we ask you to provide these for your child.

TRANSITION & SETTLING IN

Making sure your child is happy and settled at nursery is our first priority. To get to know your child, we ask that you complete our 'All About Me' document before any transition sessions. It will be helpful for us to read in advance. Several transition sessions will be offered with a flexible approach depending on each child.

We are looking forward to offering tours, stay and play and transition sessions in June and July this year.

ADMISSIONS

Our nursery admissions policy is based on a 'first come, first served' basis. Places can only be confirmed once the <u>application form</u> has been completed online. Please see our terms and conditions document for full details.


